Mission: The Rhode Island Land Trust Council promotes land conservation in Rhode Island by supporting the missions and operations of land trusts, fostering collaboration and advocating for sound land conservation policy.

About: The Rhode Island Land Trust Council is a coalition of the state's land trusts - community-based organizations formed to protect our special places: the scenic open spaces, natural areas, farms, forests, historic sites, watersheds, and drinking water supplies that define the character of our communities and our state. Land trusts are protecting our heritage so that it will be a legacy for future generations.

Brief of project: The project involves contacting leaders of land trusts around Rhode Island by email and phone and compiling information about the people/businesses/systems they are using for routine tasks such as accounting, legal work, surveying properties, insurance, tracking membership and donors, email communications, etc.

Project Timeline: Weekly hours based on intern's availability - expected 30 hours total

Learning Objectives:

- The person working on this project will get hands on experience related to customer/membership relations and surveying members to gather information that can be shared with other members.
- The person will gain experience with state policy through the Council's policy work at the Statehouse.
